Scale Model Life Volume 1 is for the hobby modeler. This issue brings together a variety of model builds, including Revell's 1/8 scale 1932 Ford Hot Rod. A Moebius Models 1/8 scale Black Widow figure model is custom built, but with a twist. Aoshima's Toyota GTII Twin Turbo car assembles into the ultimate sleeper ride, while Revell's 1/16 1934 Ford Street Rod builds into a great modern street rod. We take an in depth look at Moebius Models Tumbler "Batmobile" from the Wayne Industries and see just how different this car model is from any car we've assembled before. Monogram's Mazda RX7 makes an appearance and is built showroom stock, featuring Mazda's 13B rotary engine.
