Make a sundress, a T-Shirt skirt, a daydress, a sleeveless top, a dungaree dress shirt or pyjamas. Plus instructions for bags and shoes or slippers. If you want to make more than one doll, the author gives details and a template for drawing a face in fabric paint and ironing it on. Although the author says that 'with just a few essential sewing skills and a collection of basic materials you can create your own unique and special doll', I would agree with previous reviewer that you'd never achieve that professional look without a sewing machine. Very cute and inspiring.
