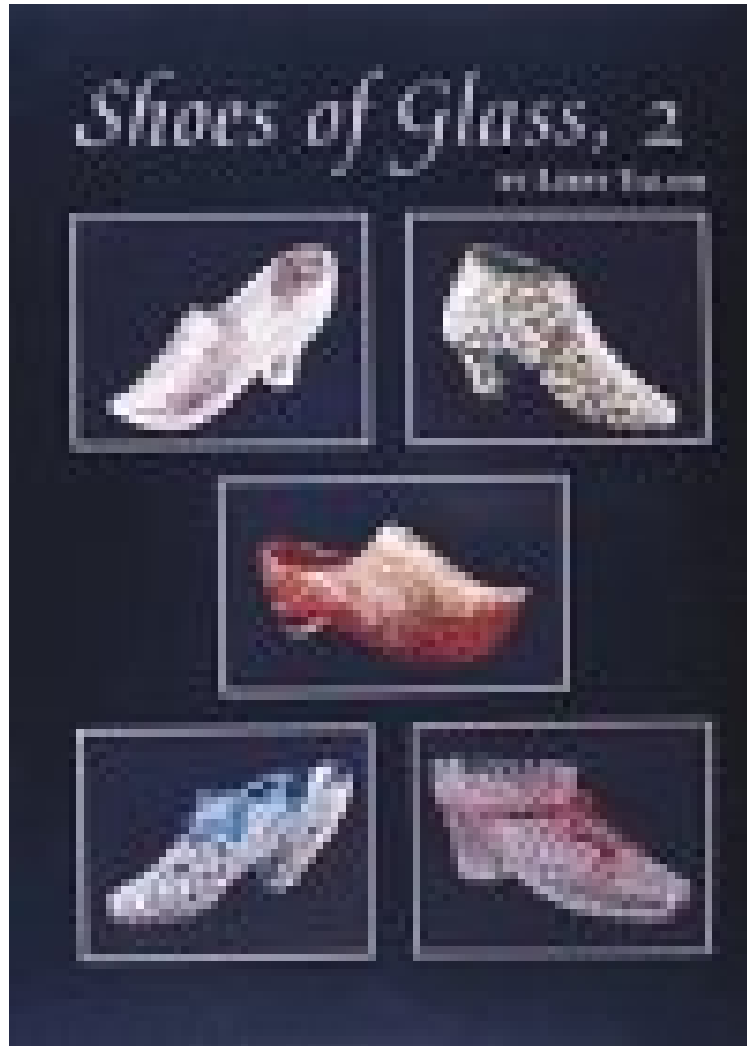


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Shoes of Glass, 2

About the Author: Libby Yalom began collecting shoes in 1971 after receiving one as a gift, and started researching them shortly thereafter. Information was sparse at the time, and Libby was driven by a desire to know as much as possible about each piece in her collection, and a knack for detail. A pioneer in glass shoe research, she is known as The Shoe Lady in many glass collecting circles, and keeps a meticulous card file with information on over 3,000 glass and china shoes that she has researched, collected, bought and/or sold over the last 25 years.
