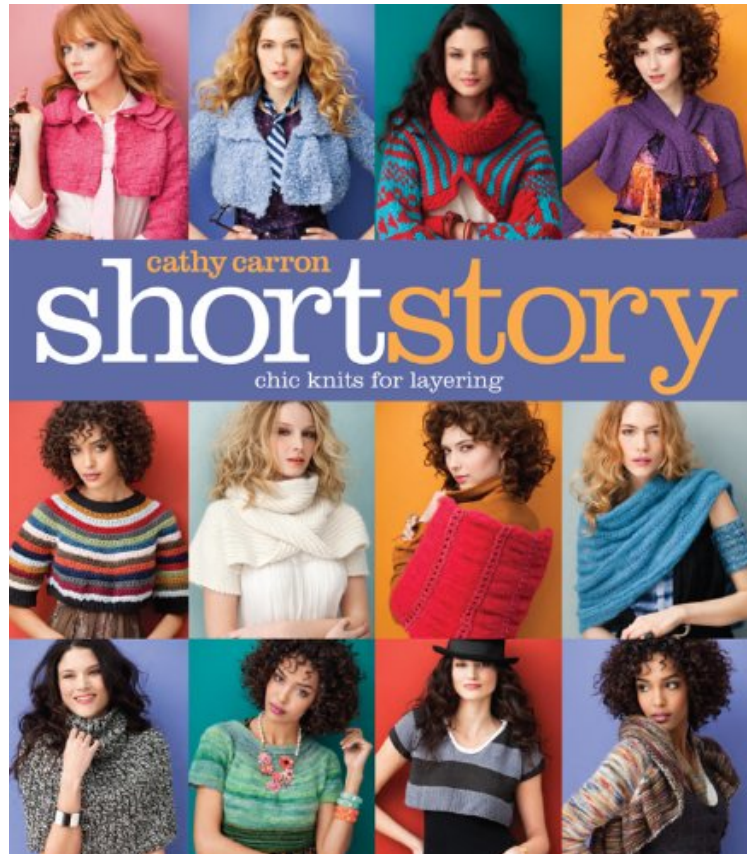

Carron also includes a brief look at the various forms explored, considers yarn and stitch pattern, gives advice on adjusting for length, and offers ideas for styling short knits. From a ruffled bolero in a painter's palette of gorgeous hand-painted yarns to a short'n sweet cashmere and silk capelet, these designs are as pleasing to the fingers as they are to the eyes!
