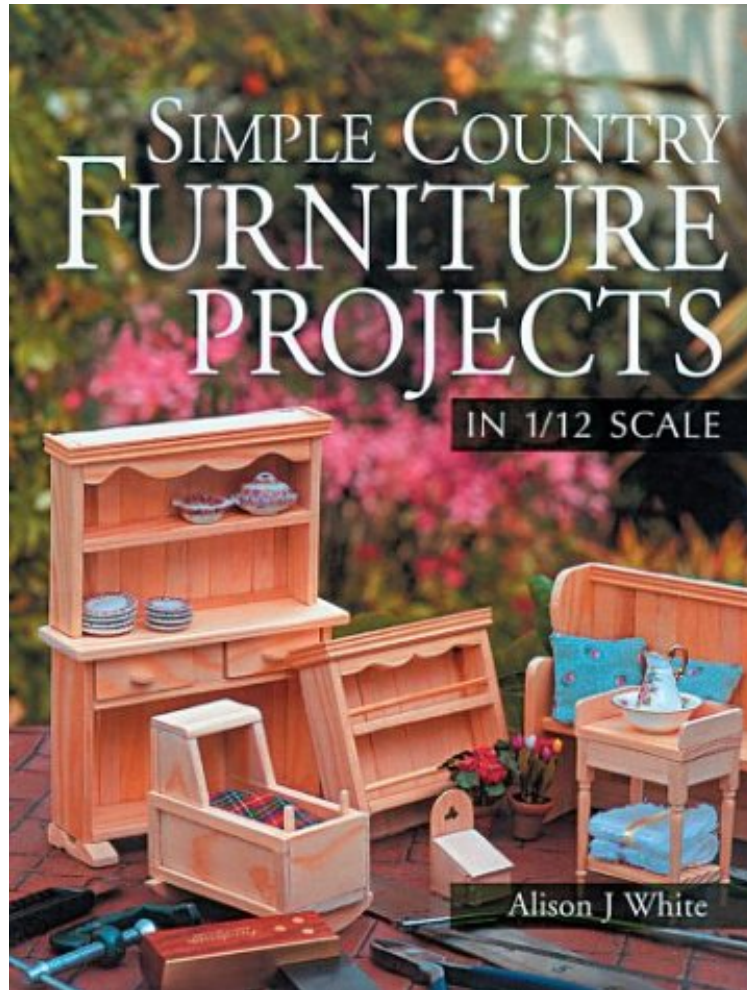

the instructions easy to follow and my results have been great. A beginner can probably be successful in building these project as they are presented in increasing order of difficulty--you can learn as your go. Only difficulty has been the author only provided width and length dimensions. There is no information for the thickness of strip wood. If the project is built with 1/16' wood it will be different than building with 3/8" and result in having to adjust dimension of a later cut piece of wood. The look may also be different.
