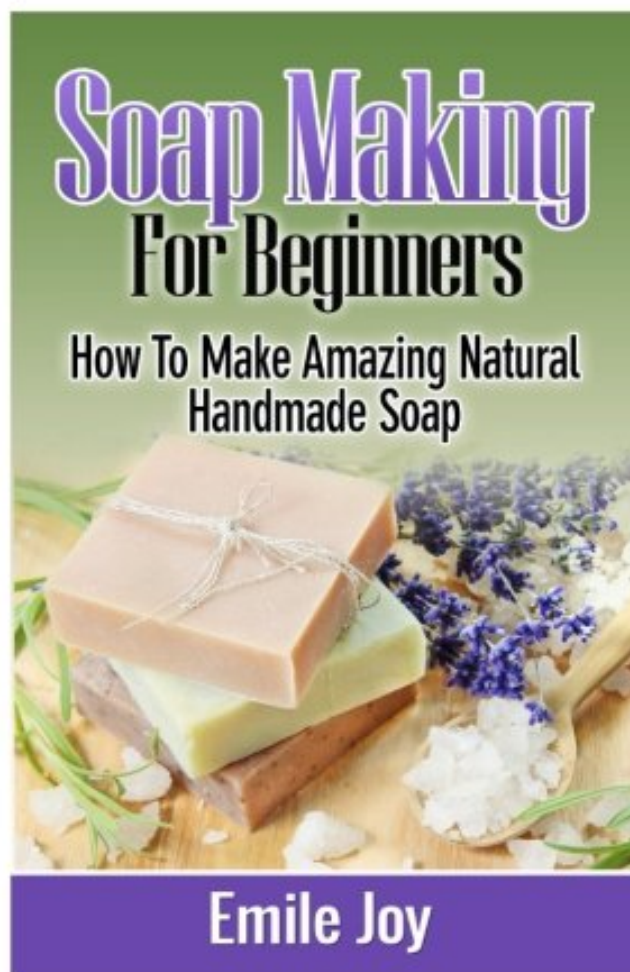

Please do not use this book. The recipes written are dangerous. All soap recipes you receive should be put through a soap calculator to ensure they're safe. Soap requires the use of Lye, which can cause severe burns when used improperly. A proper recipe will allow for no lye excess, so the lye and the fats properly saponify and you end up with - soap! If a bar of soap has extra lye left over, it's very dangerous. Soap recipes are also not measured in baking terms (tsp. cups) but rather weight to ensure proper measurements to prevent lye excess. As a good rule of thumb, if a recipe is measured in baking terms, walk away from it. This book also has a recipe that contains a recipe so dangerous that it would burn skin and possibly blind you if you used it on your face. The oatmeal exfoliating bar. The recipe is missing any fats needed to for the lye to saponify, which means you'd end up with a water, lye, oatmeal scrub. Not good at all. This book should be removed from ASAP. For a good source of beginners recipes and information, refer to the Soap Queen. She has a blog with safe recipes and video tutorials to get you started, for free.

Please do not use this book!!! The recipes contained are inaccurate and very troubling. Additionally, the Homemade Exfoliating Oatmeal Soap will cause severe lye burns. There are missing ingredients and wrong amounts. If you are a new soaper, please check out some of the Newbie Soaper groups on Facebook, watch YouTube Videos from SoapQueen TV or Soaping 101. These are geared for new soapers. Also check out some of the wonderful books that has to offer from Soapers that have been in the industry for years, Anne-Marie Faiola, Alicia Grosso, Anne L. All soap formulas should be run through SoapCalc Lye Calculator or other calculators that do the same thing to ensure that your formula is safe to use.
