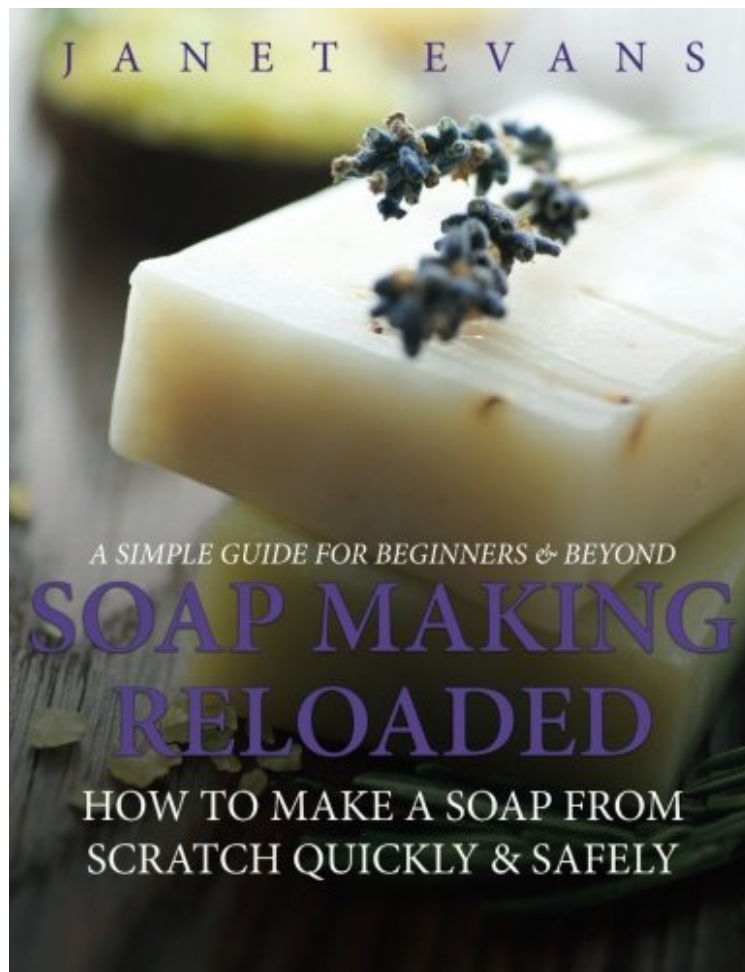

There is a short section on the history of soap and the different types of soap. The author then explains the terminology that she will be using when talking about the soap making processes. Safety is not neglected and that is an important issue to consider if working with lye. A saponification chart is included for the most common oils. After the discussion about the different methods there is a test recipe for the beginner. I was a bit disappointed to see only the cold process discussed in detail. I felt the other processes could have had more details and less time spent on marketing and creating your own business. Overall a helpful book, particularly on the things you need to do before you begin to create your own soap.
