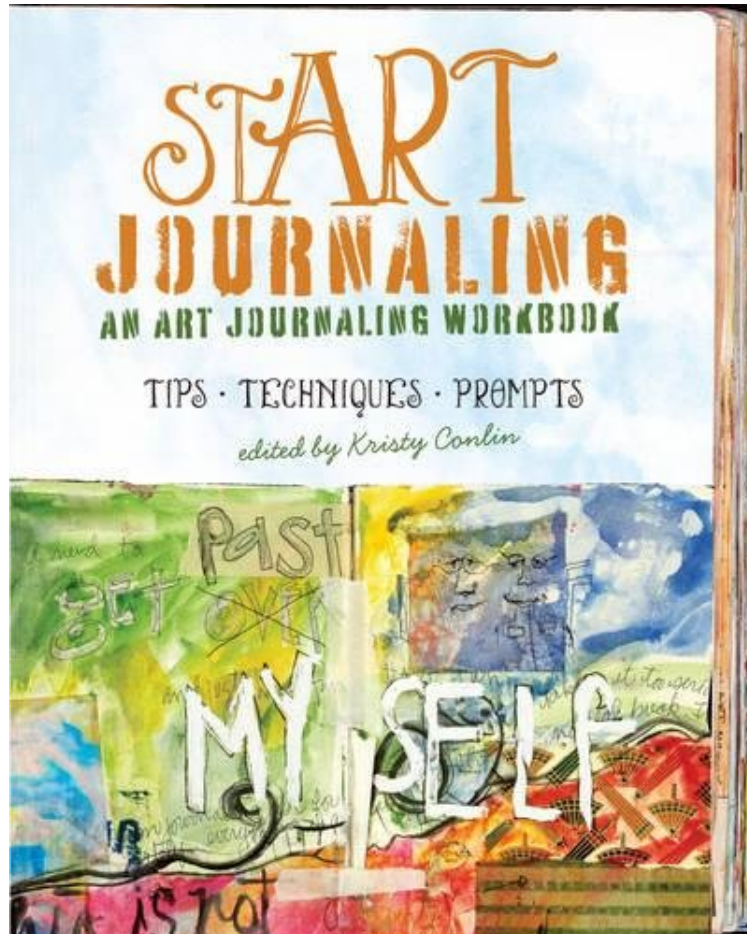

If I had wanted a blank journal, I would have purchased a beautiful Strathmore journal with 90 lb. or 140 lb. watercolor paper, which would be perfect for journaling. With so many outstanding mixed media and journal artists working and publishing today, this author would have benefited by including wonderful examples of their work, with specific suggestions and techniques about how to create their luscious pages and collages. The few instructional pages included are dismally amateurish and uninspired. I have bought nearly every collage, art journal and mixed media book offered by and loved every one of them. That's why I threw away the shipping envelope and receipt before exploring this book. Otherwise I would have
