It's kind of silly but there's a color wheel showing the primary, secondary and tertiary colors. This just emphasizes the lack of color. I might have given this 3 or even 2 stars because I don't do needlepoint. But that's not her fault...and the book is in bw because it was published over 40 years ago. This is a tidy little book with which you can remind yourself of stitches you haven't used in a while or learn new ones. I count about 20 including basic petit point (half cross stitch) and tent stitch. One you might like to try is the turkey stitch which created a shag rug effect with wool (or velvet with a finer fiber). This is a small book, about 6.5 by 7.5 inches.
