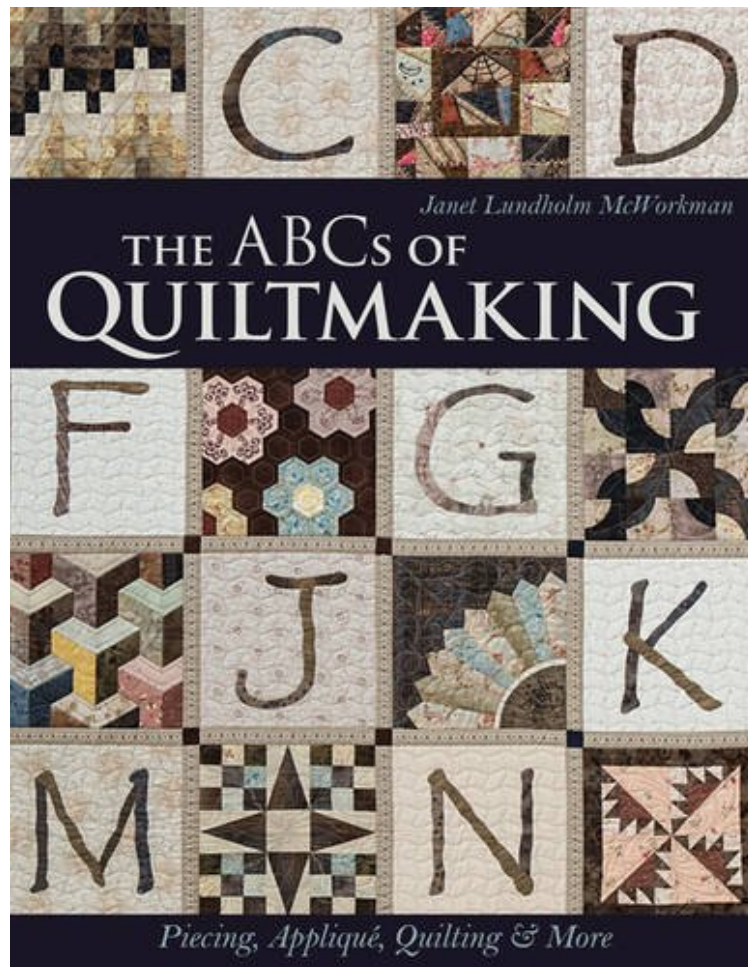

The more basic pointers are at the beginning, and skills build as you go, and if you make each block as given, you will end up with a wall hanging to showcase the skills learned. Every element is covered, with helpful tips and photographs. The book works as a beginner's reference, as a refresher, and as a substitute classroom for anyone who cannot attend lessons in person. As well as instructions for the wall hanging blocks, there are other projects interspersed so that you can gain a sense of achievement in creating a finished product without having to read the whole book first. At just over 80 pages, this is not a large book, but it is jam packed with information, guidance and technical detail.
