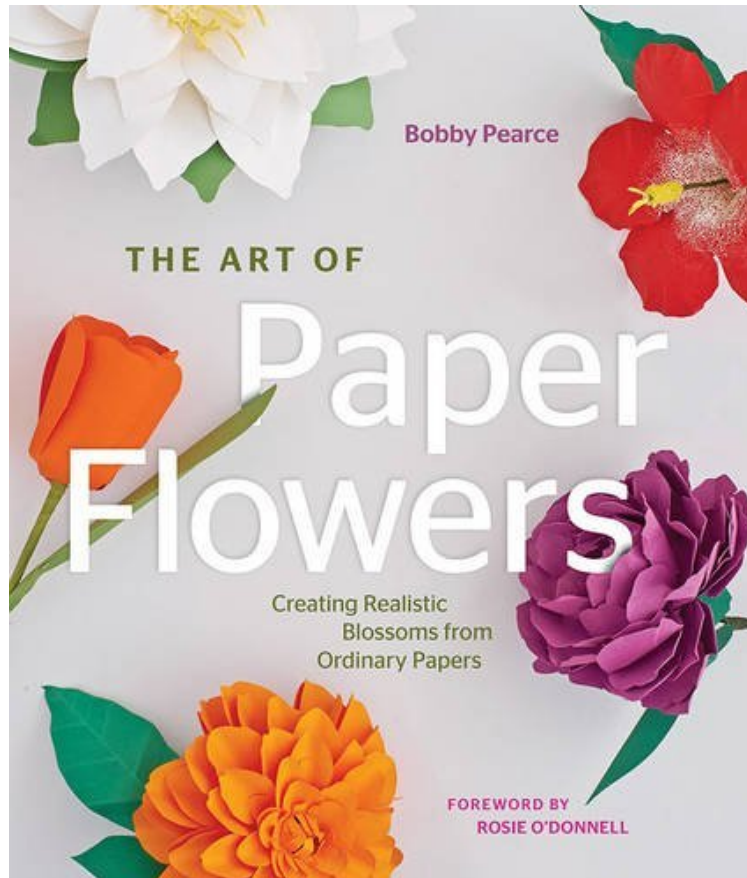

The flowers are very pretty and the pictures are fabulous. In just looking at the book, however, I don't think the instructions are that great. I love the backstory of the grandma (mine sewed), and the glossary of the patterns are great, but I think the instructions are lacking. It will be difficult for me to follow his instructions. For instance, the 'fan-folding' is just not clear enough for me. How many times do you fold the paper. Speaking of paper, I stupidly, did not realize that Bobby Pearce uses scrapbook paper for his flowers when I bought the book. I thought this book uses crepe paper. The flowers are very 'artistic', but I am not sure how realistic they are/will be when I make them. Since I have crepe paper, I am going to try

making them with crepe paper to see if I can convert the patterns and instructions for crepe paper. 3 of 3 people found the following review helpful. A enthusiastic foreword by Rosie O'Donnell creates the stage to gather supplies and begin making each flower. The author's personal touch of introducing each flower with a bit of history, or myth or linguistic infusion stirs the creative juices to flow. The back grey pages provide the patterns for petal and leaf to trace. Basic supplies of scissors, wire cutters, glue, paper, floral tape, wire and paint are not expensive and accessible in a local craft/art store.
