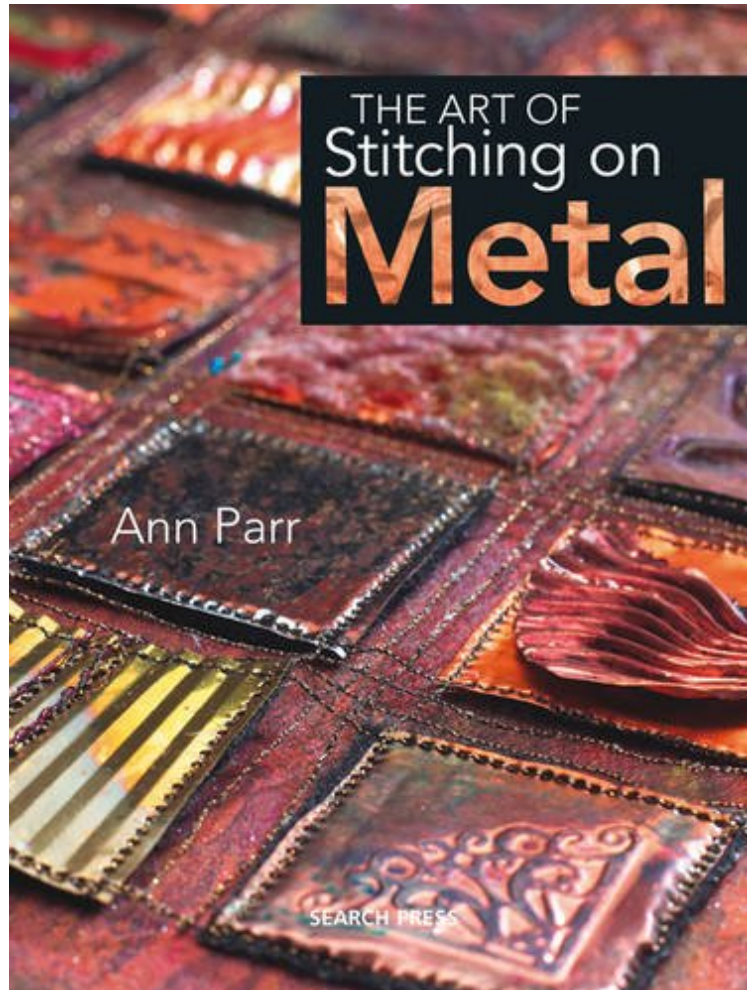

She covers everything from types of metals, fabrics and finishes and wires and threads to heating; using corrosive substances and adding texture to metal. You'll learn how to add color, foiling, embossing powder, glitter and webbing spray. Then work your way through the stitching section of this book and discover methods for adding straight and free-motion stitches while you create projects like broaches, boxes and bookmarks. Use decorative, automatic machine stitches to create additional surface effects on an embroidered cuff and use woven strips of metal to create a quirky metal doll. Other projects include greeting cards, woven panels and beads. Directions are clearly written, easy to follow and have full-color photo illustrations. It's impossible not to be inspired by the beautifully photographed, finished projects in this book. A must-have for any mixed-media, paper or fiber artist who wants to explore working with metal.

Twelve projects include a beautiful pewter pendant, a colourful brooch, decorative panels to adorn your home, and a fabulous metal-woven doll.
