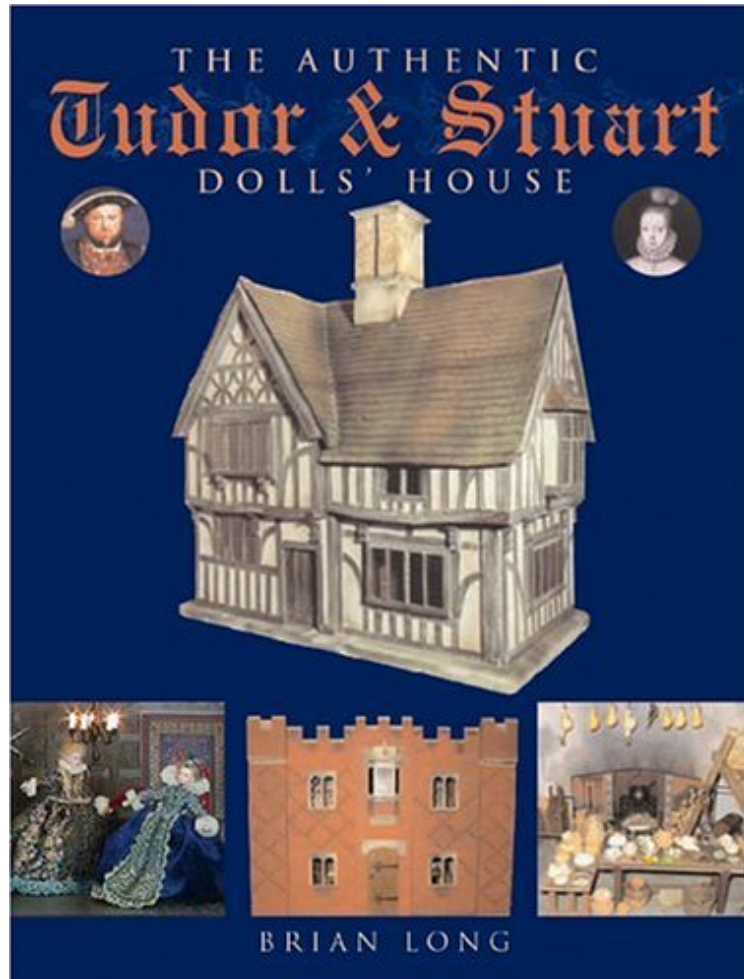

This book fills the bill in many ways. There are many, many color photos! Photos of historical medieval manors and halls include details of structural and architectural changes that have occurred since the initial construction. Photos show models of fully furnished dollhouse rooms, created in detail according to the historical information presented. It's packed with drawings. There are multiple drawings of many of the items one would find in a medieval home. For example page 129 shows drawings of four different styles of fork with approximate dates accompanying each model and a short description of the functionality of each style. Page 20 shows twenty drawings of different decorated square panels in

the western midlands of England. Page 59 shows seven different styles of door hinges, with the dates, of course. There are six pages about windows and four more about shutters! Did children have toys? Page 168. Where were the dogs kept? Page 183. Where did people go to the bathroom? Pages 87 and 88. Yes, two pages just for that! There is an entire chapter of inventories from medieval homes that demonstrate the historical accuracy of the details. Accurate terminology is used throughout. If you really want to build a dollhouse, you'll find detailed directions, drawings in stages that including measurements and scaled patterns. In some cases, there are photos of an original area in an actual historical building, directions for creating a dollhouse scale copy, and patterns to use. Pages 164 and 165 even include a colored photo of a beautiful painted ceiling from Crathes Castle in Scotland, explains the mythology and portraits depicted. When you turn the page, for the outline of the paintings on the panels and directions for painting them and using them to line your dollhouse. Do I recommend this book?
