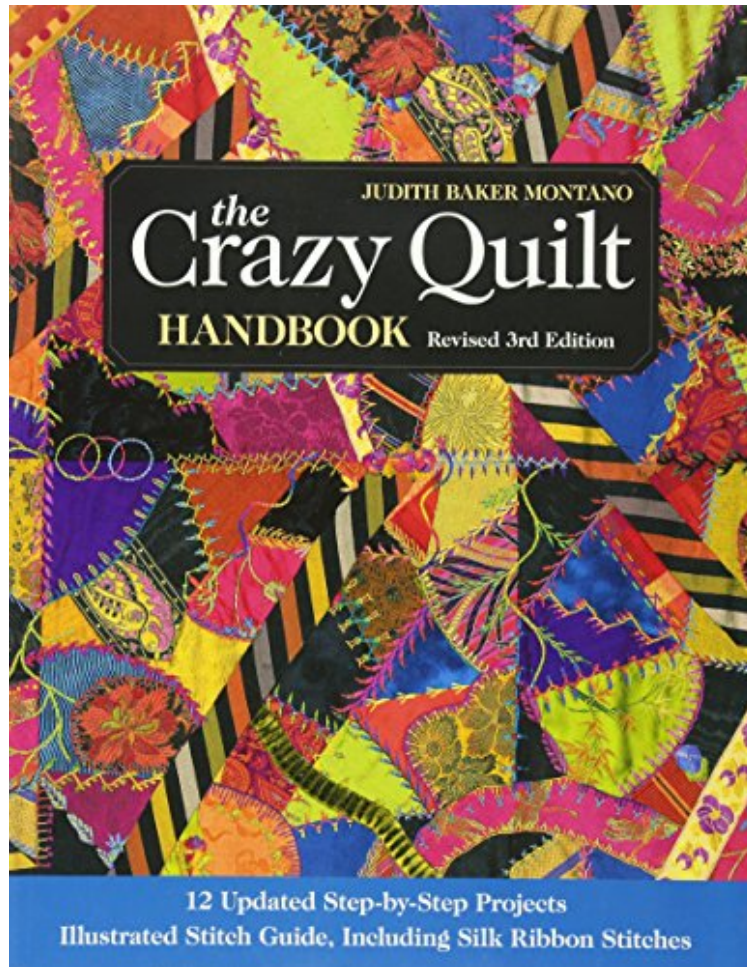

I did not get very far and the photos do not match up with the text intended for the photo. It makes it very difficult to follow. It started at the

beginning where Ms Montano is talking about color and has samples. I could not figure out why the photos did not look like what she was describing and then a little while later I noticed the photos showing what I read were a swipe or two later. Then she started explaining about the center fabric piece and how to stitch and flip around it. Again, the photos did not match and that was extremely confusing and I was really not able to match them up right because of the swiping forward and backward to compare text with photos. I can't review the book entirely because it got too confusing because of the mismatching in the Kindle version. I can say that I have already formed my own ideas from what I have read. I have given it 4 stars because what little I have read really inspired me and got my mind working, thinking of my own ideas.
