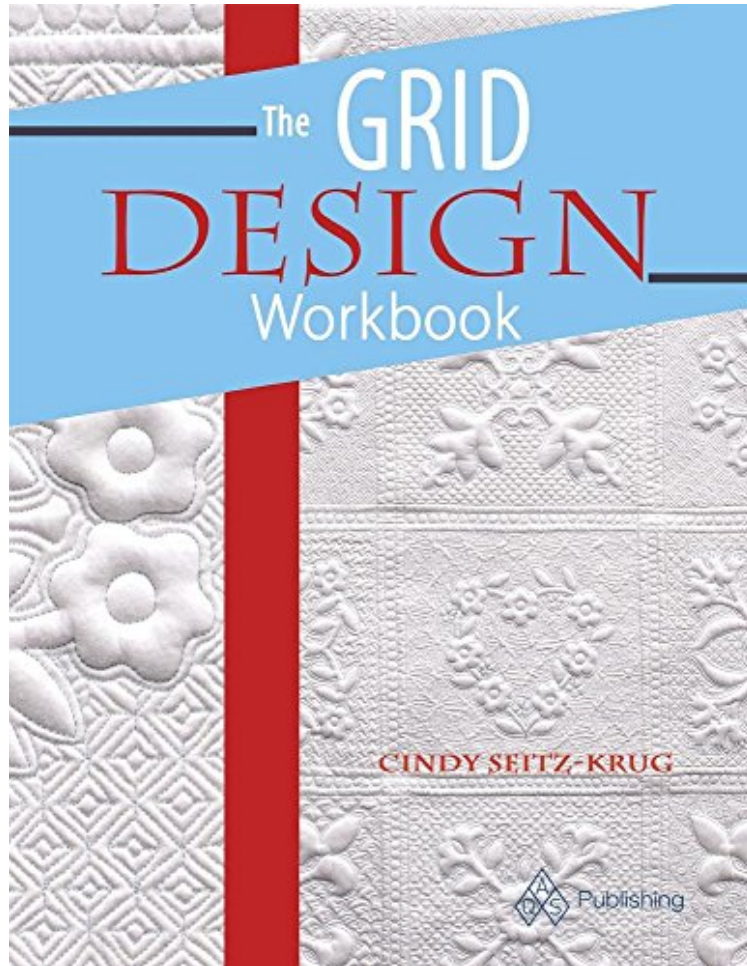

My vote - today - is for Cindy Needhams Life is Fragile Handle With Prayer. It is a black and white clamshell beauty

whose lacy effects defy description and adequate breath intake. This inventive author uses both whole-cloth and pieced quilts throughout the book. In fact, the book is organized mostly by the grids that create the blocks of the whole-cloth quilt on the cover. I was looking all over the book to find a photo of that project in its entirety, getting quite frustrated despite viewing the drop-dead (but get up again) lovely examples and gallery shots. Hint: look near the very last page.
